

Is it painful? No.

The Fibroscan® examination is painless, quick and easy. During measurement, you feel a slight vibration on the skin at the tip of the probe.

What does the Fibroscan® examination consist of?

- You lie on your back, with your right arm raised behind your head. Physician applies a water-based gel to the skin and places the probe with a slight pressure.
- The examination includes 10 consecutive measurements made at the same location.
- The result is delivered at the end of the examination, it's a number which can vary from 1.5 to 75 kPa. Your doctor will interpret the result.

What is Fibroscan®?

Examination with Fibroscan®, also called transient elastography, is a technique used to assess liver stiffness (measured in kPa correlated to fibrosis) without human body intrusion.

The result is immediate, it shows the evolution of the liver health and allows physicians to diagnose and monitor disease evolution regardless of treatment or collateral factors.

Exam result helps to anticipate various complications, as well as to monitor and assess the damages caused by diseases such as cirrhosis.

What to do with the result?

Your physician interprets the result according to your record and your disease.

Who can prescribe the Fibroscan® examination?

At the appropriate time, your physician or hepatologist will indicate the best place for you to do the examination.

LIVER STIFFNESS DETERMINES THE LEVEL OF FIBROSIS.

Soft liver = normal

Stiff liver = fibrosis

Fibroscan® measures liver stiffness that may be subject to variation due to inflammation and fibrosis stage.
